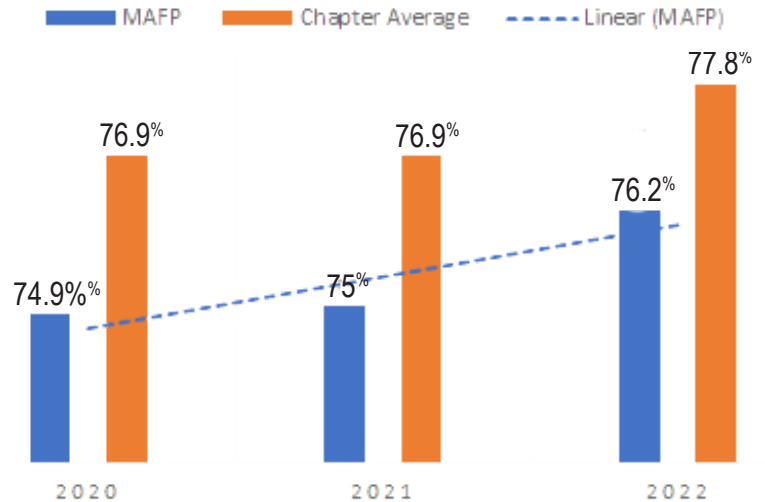

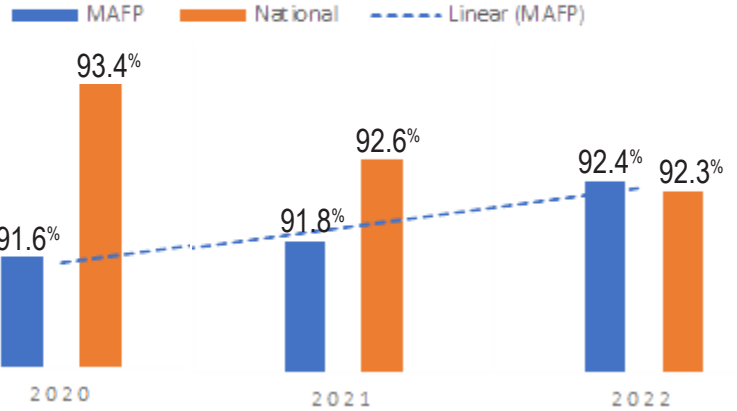
ANNUAL MARKETSHARE

2020, 2021, 2022

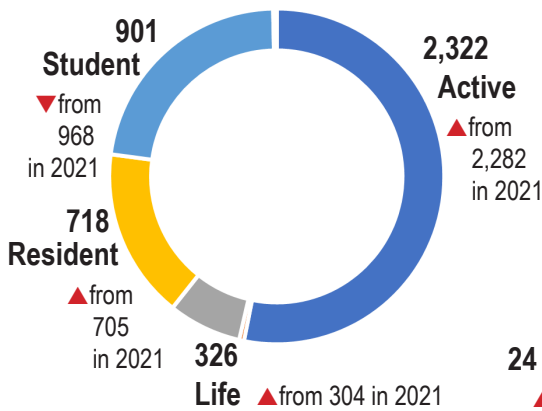


ANNUAL ACTIVE MEMBER RETENTION
