FAMILY MEDICINE SUMMER EXTERNSHIP PROGRAM

Each year, Family Medicine Foundation of Michigan selects student members of MAFP to participate in a 4-6 week clinical and/or research experience tailored to their interests and under the mentorship of a family physician member of MAFP. The goal is to stimulate student interest in the family physician specialty. Selected externs receive a \$2,000 stipend after completing the externship. Funding is provided by matching grants from Family Medicine Foundation of Michigan and AAFP Foundation.

Congratulations to the Michigan Academy of Family Physicians (MAFP) student externs for 2024: **Claire Lupini**, Michigan State University College of Human Medicine Class of 2026 and **Stephen Venable**, Wayne State School of Medicine Class of 2025.

Lupini worked alongside Scott Ross, MD at the MyMichigan Family Medicine Residency program in both the outpatient family practice clinic and in the setting of labor and delivery.

"Before entering this externship, I was interested in family medicine as my career, but I had not been able to spend a lot of time in depth experiencing what it was like to take care of a panel of patients," said Lupini. "I was also curious about the role of a family physician in taking care of patients that are pregnant and seeing them through their delivery. This externship gave me the opportunity to observe and participate in both aspects of patient care and I can confidently say that I cannot wait to spend my career as a family physician."

Venable worked with Richard Bryce, DO at the Community Health and Social Services Center (CHASS) Center in Detroit.

"The care we provided included a wide array of services such as new patient and follow-up visits, joint injections, perinatal care, ultrasounds, gender affirming care, social and psychological support, and much more. Yet it was while working with Street Medicine Detroit providing care in the back alleyways of the city that I truly realized there is no place that family medicine does not touch," Venable said. "I have been deeply inspired by my experience to be able to practice family medicine in whatever way the community needs most and I am thankful for the chance that this externship provided me; I encourage anyone interested in family medicine to apply to explore their own journey!"

➤ EXPLORE YOUR PASSION FOR FAMILY MEDICINE

Interested students should collaborate with their medical school to identify a family physician mentor/preceptor and plan the externship. Eligibility includes being a full-time student at an accredited medical school in Michigan, an MAFP student member, and interested in exploring a career as a family physician, with a mentor who is a family physician member of MAFP in good standing.
